All Park District positions require persons who are responsible, dependable, friendly and courteous to the public. Most positions involve weekend, holiday and/or evening hours. Applications and complete job descriptions are available at the Freeport Park District Office Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. When completing the application, please list all positions you might be interested in. Thank you.

Krape Park Facilities Attendant: \$7.75 - \$8.75 per hour; Facility Attendants perform a variety of jobs including Merry-go-round, Mini-golf and Boat Rentals. Responsible for ensuring safety, enforcing rules, customer service, efficiency and cash control for facility operations. Must be at least 16 years of age. Hours vary, but general hours of operation are Monday – Sunday, Noon – 10:30 PM.

Krape Park Assistant Facilities Manager: \$8.50 - \$10.00 per hour; Responsible for the daily operation of the Merry-go-round, Mini-golf and Boat Rentals, and supervision of Facility Attendants. Must be able to attain certification in First Aid and CPR. High School Diploma or equivalent required. Hours vary.

Read Park Pool Concessions Attendant: \$7.75 - \$8.75 per hour; Concessions Attendants are responsible for ensuring safety, customer service, efficiency and cash control for concession operations. May assist with Aquatic Center admissions. Hours vary, but general hours of operation are Monday – Sunday, Noon – 8:00 PM.

Taylor Park Concessions Attendant: \$7.75 - \$9.00 per hour; Concessions Attendants are responsible for ensuring safety, customer service, efficiency and cash control for concession operations. Hours vary, but general hours of operation are Monday – Friday, 6:00 – 10:00 PM, some weekend hours.

Assistant Pool Manager: \$9.00 - \$11.00 per hour; Responsible for the daily operation of the Read Park Family Aquatic Center and supervision of lifeguard staff. Must be certified in Red Cross Lifeguarding, WSI, First Aid and CPR. High School Diploma or equivalent required. Hours vary.

Lifeguards: \$7.75 - \$8.75 per hour; Must be certified in Red Cross Lifeguarding, First Aid and CPR. Hours vary.

Cashiers/Pool Attendant: \$7.75 - \$8.25 per hour; Provide customer service to Pool guests, sell daily admissions and annual pool passes, keep accurate records, crowd control, housekeeping of facilities, enforcement of pool rules and other duties as assigned. Hours vary.

Swimming Instructors: \$8.25 - \$9.00 per hour; Instruct District Learn-to-Swim programs, Red Cross water safety instructor certification required; ability to work with children and adults, teach basic strokes of swimming following Red Cross program. Hours vary.

Youth Athletics Instructors: \$8.00 - \$10.00 per hour; Plan, organize and teach tee-ball, soccer, tennis, basketball, football and/or other sports skills to children, ages 4-12 years; Weekdays including evenings.

Program Leaders: \$7.75 - \$9.00 per hour; Plan, organize and lead a variety of sports, games, nature activities, art & craft class, for youth between the ages 4-12 years. Weekday and Weekend hours.

Day Camp Counselor: \$7.75 - \$9.00 per hour; Plan, organize and lead a variety of nature-based activities, group cooperative games, arts & crafts, and other camp activities. Must be experienced working with children ages 8 – 12 years. Must be able to attain certifications in First Aid and CPR. Weekday hours.

Day Camp Program Manager: \$8.25 - \$10.00 per hour; Responsible for the daily operation of Summer Day Camp and supervision of Day Camp Counselors. Plan, organize and lead a variety of nature-based activities, group cooperative games, arts & crafts, and short educational activities. Must be 18 years or older. H.S. Diploma or equivalent required. Must be able to obtain certifications in First Aid and CPR. Weekday hours.

Jr. Tackle Cheerleading Coach: \$7.75 - \$9.00 per hour; Supervision of cheerleaders at all practice and games. Develop curriculum for teaching a variety of cheers to the cheerleaders, including proper hand and body movements. Hours vary.

Special Recreation Program Leaders: \$8.25 - \$10.00 per hour; All Park District programs, including swim lessons, tee-ball, day camps and bus trips, are available to people with disabilities. Support staff provides that extra assistance needed for the disabled individual to gain the best experience from the program; coordinated through Special Recreation Supervisor. Hours vary.

Sand Volleyball Score Keepers: \$7.75 - \$8.50 per game; Keep score of league games; must have knowledge of sand volleyball rules. Monday and Wednesday evenings.

Softball Officials: \$15 - \$20 per game; Must be able to attain **USSSA** certification. We can help you become certified. Hours vary.

Ball Diamond Maintenance: \$7.75 - \$9.00 per hour; Duties include field preparation for adult softball games, overall ball diamond aesthetics, and specific duties assigned by the Athletics Supervisor. Hours vary.

Park Maintenance: \$7.75 - \$10.00 per hour; Seasonal maintenance workers perform a variety of physical labor tasks for outdoor and indoor building and grounds maintenance, including mowing & trimming; trash & litter pickup; planting, weeding, raking, digging, painting and other tasks as assigned by Maintenance Supervisor. Hours are generally dayshift, but vary with some weekends.

Golf Course Maintenance: \$8.25 - \$10.00 per hour; Responsible for mowing, grounds maintenance, cleaning, trash & litter pickup, weeding, raking, planting, digging, and other physical labor tasks as assigned. Hours are generally dayshift, but vary with some weekends.

Parks Hills Golf Course Pro Shop Attendant: \$8.25 - \$10.00 per hour; Responsible for daily operations of the Pro Shop and Driving Range. Other duties as assigned by Golf Professional. Hours vary.

Park Hills Golf Course Kitchen Attendant: \$8.25 - \$10.00 per hour; Responsible for taking food and beverage orders, food preparation, washing dishes, cleaning tables and other duties as assigned. Hours vary.
